The Thailand Team Invitational will take place from April 22nd to 28th, 2026. We arrive in Bangkok and wind our way to the popular beach resort town of Hua Hin.

Hua Hin is a thriving tourist hotspot with great beaches & seemingly endless restaurants and has become a fantastic golf destination with an abundance of championship golf courses, with many nominated in the world golf awards best course in Thailand category.

The Thailand Team Invitational will be played over 3 rounds on some of Thailand's best courses, this event is an individual and team tournament, invitations are for teams (4 players) to compete. The event is limited to the first 9 teams entered (36 players), for those people who don't have a team and wish to enter individually we will place you into a team for the event should vacancies arise.

All competitors will stay at the Hilton Hua Hin Resort and Spa for 3 nights during the tournament, then onto the 5 Star Westin Grande Hotel in Bangkok for 3 nights (or more should you wish to extend) before transferring to the airport for your departure.

We are fortunate to be playing superb golf courses including Pineapple Valley, Black Mountain and Nikanti. We will also play other layouts including Royal Bang Pa and The Siam Country Clubs Bangkok Course.

Accommodation has been reserved at the five-star Hilton Resort and Spa Hotel for the first 3 nights and 3 nights at the Westin Grande in Bangkok.



On arrival in Hua Hin we will hold the welcome party with drinks and finger food where you will receive your event gift pack and any further information on the tournament.

As most people will have travelled for almost 12 hours to get to Thailand, we suggest a good night's rest. Day 1 will be an round at Pineapple Valley Golf Club. Your Team will play together in a best ball event. It is a friendly competition and not part of the team tournament.

After 2 rounds of competition on fantastic golf courses it will time to travel back towards Bangkok to play Nikanti, one of Asia's best courses.

The next morning, we play the final round of the Team championship at Royal Bang Pa, before the final day Calcutta round which will be held at Siam Country Club – Bangkok.

Competitions: As with most golf tours there will be a fair number of side bets taking place. There will be separate competition for every round on the tour and to give everyone a chance of winning we will adopt a special handicapping system.

Handicaps- Everyone will play the first round of the tour on their normal club handicap, after each round players will be re-handicapped down or up depending on their previous day's score. The maximum handicap movement will be 2 strokes a day.

The betting fund (prize pool) there will be prize pool set up with all players expected to put in THB3000 (+/- \$150). Daily prize money will be for first, second and third stableford points.

Calcutta: There will be a Calcutta held in conjunction with final round of the tournament. The format for the Calcutta will be a team's 2 ball best ball stableford. Once the draw is completed the teams will be auctioned.

If you enjoy playing world class golf courses in a competitive tournament environment, top class accommodation, a few side bets and having a great time -- then enter today or better still get three of your friends or club members to enter as well and make up a team.

The Tournament

The tournament will be played over 3 rounds ... 1 at Black Mountain Golf Club, 1 round at Nikanti Golf Club, 1 round at Royal Bang Pa.In. The other rounds will be at Siam Country Club – Bangkok and Pineapple Valley Golf Club.

There will be individual competitions and the team's competition.

The individual competition will be a stableford event, with daily and overall prizes there will also be a 2 ball best ball team Stableford competition for players on the last day.

The Teams event will have daily and overall prizes.

Team's event will be played as follows:

Each team will be made up of 4 players A, B, C, and D

Two of the team members will play together each day, (with two players from another team.)

The team members will rotate partners each day, so all team members will have a different playing partner each round.

Round one players A & B will play with 2 players from another team as will C & D

Round two players A & C, will play with 2 players from another team as will B & D

Round three players A & D will play with 2 players from another team as will B & C

The competition will be the pair's best ball stableford (best score on each hole from one player)

The team's score will be the total of both pair's best ball stableford scores each day.

Eg: Round 1 Players A & B = 44 points

 Players C & D = 46 points

Team Total round 1 would be 90 points. And so on for the 3 tournament rounds.

There will be a Cutcutta / Auction for teams on the final days play.
